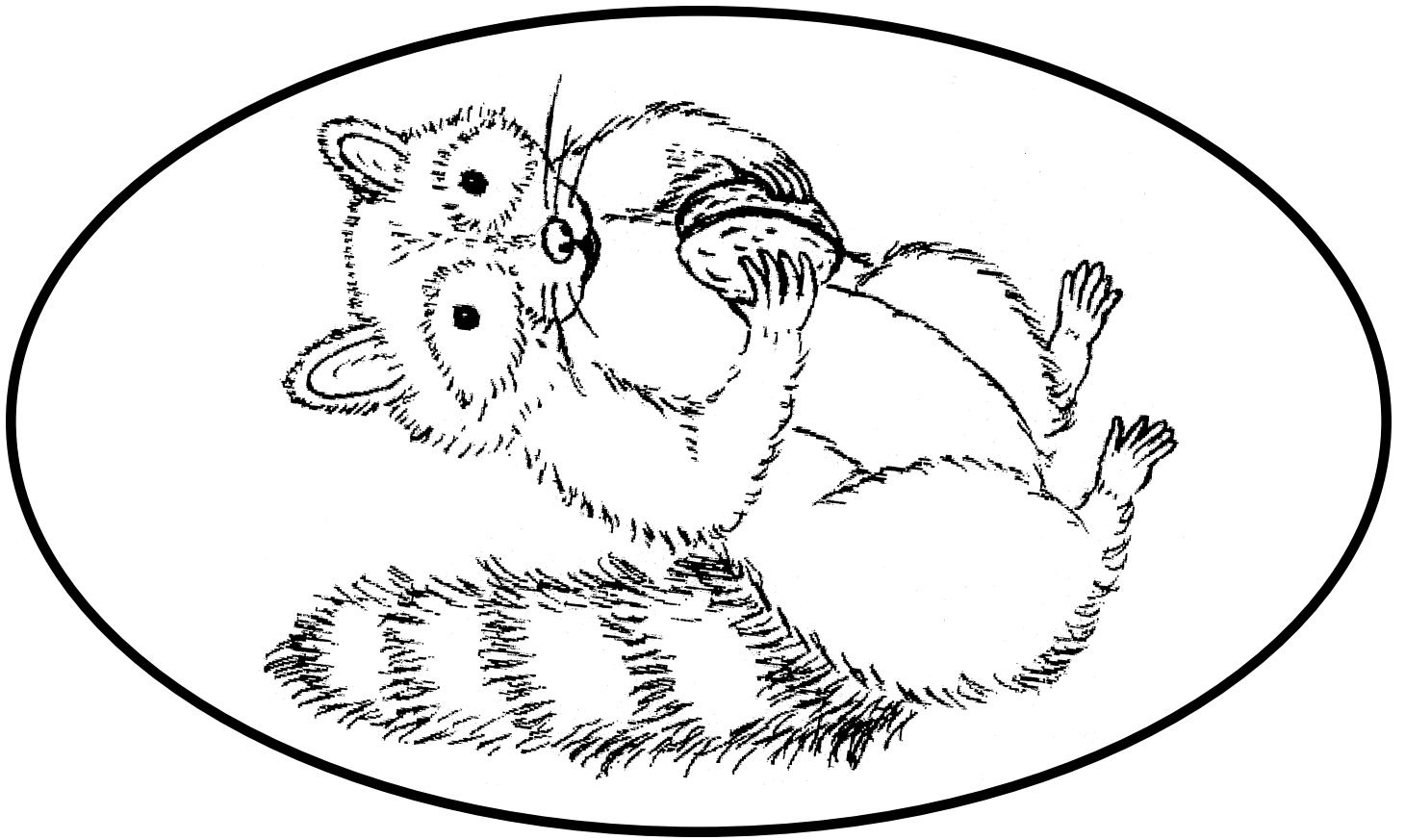
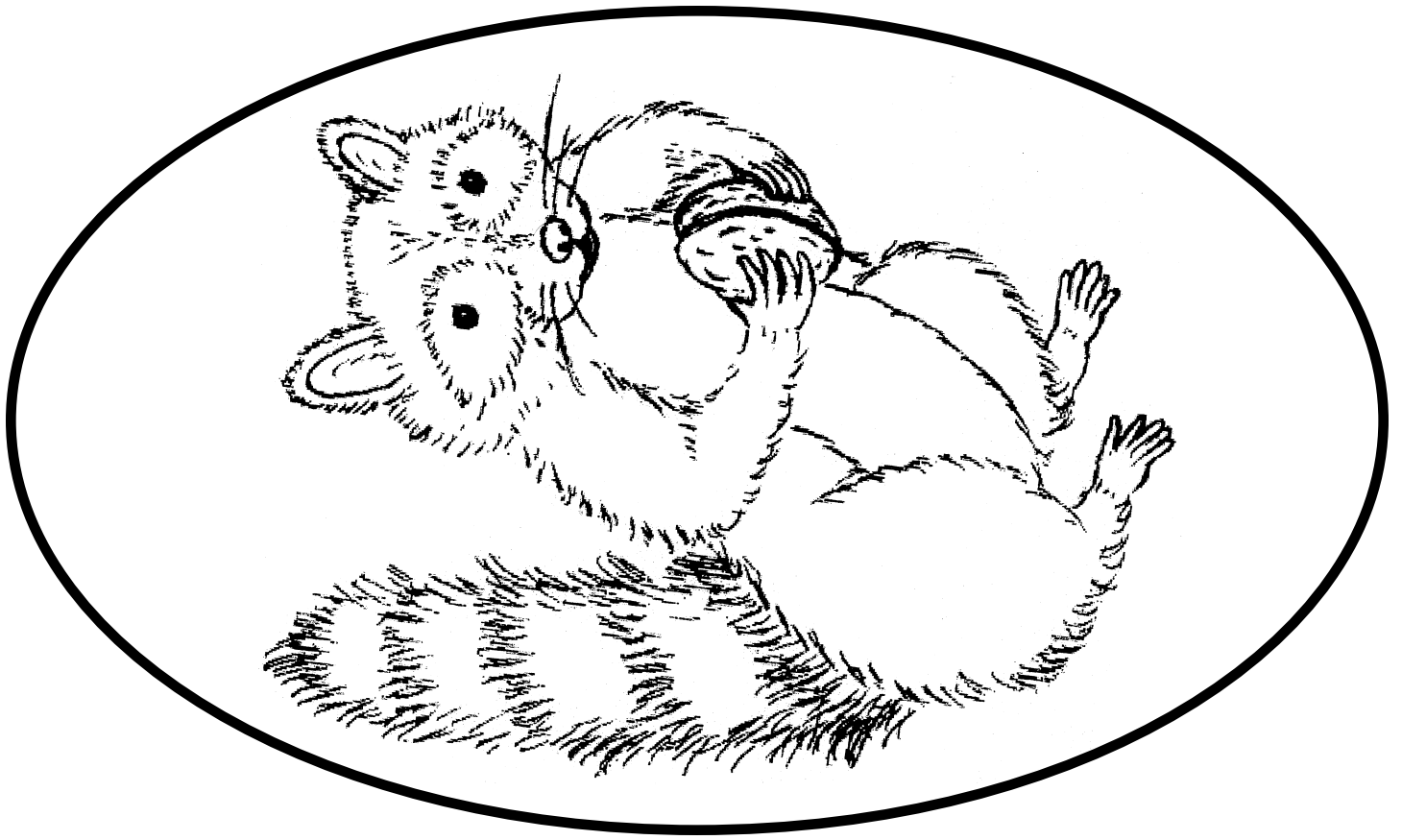
Supplies needed:

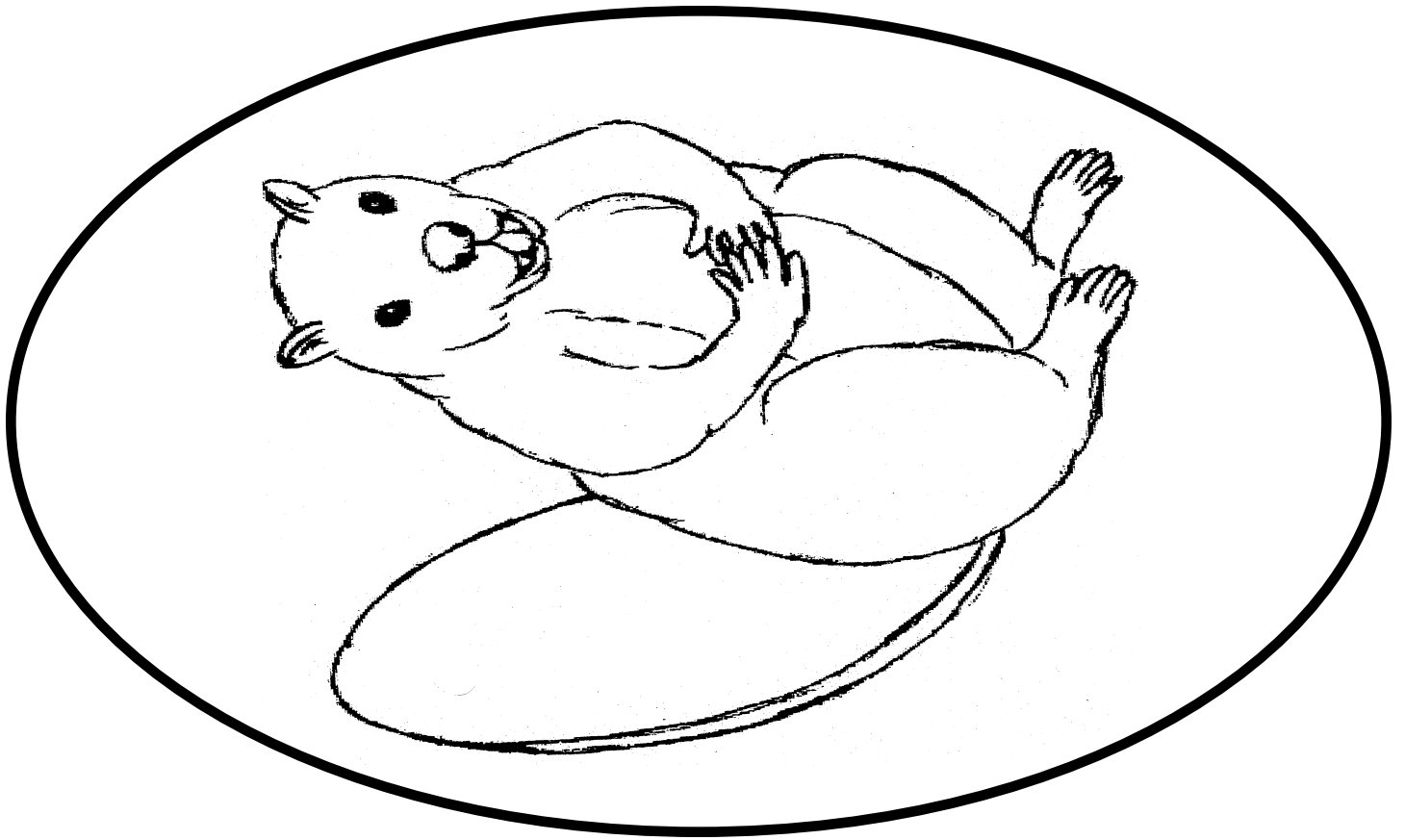
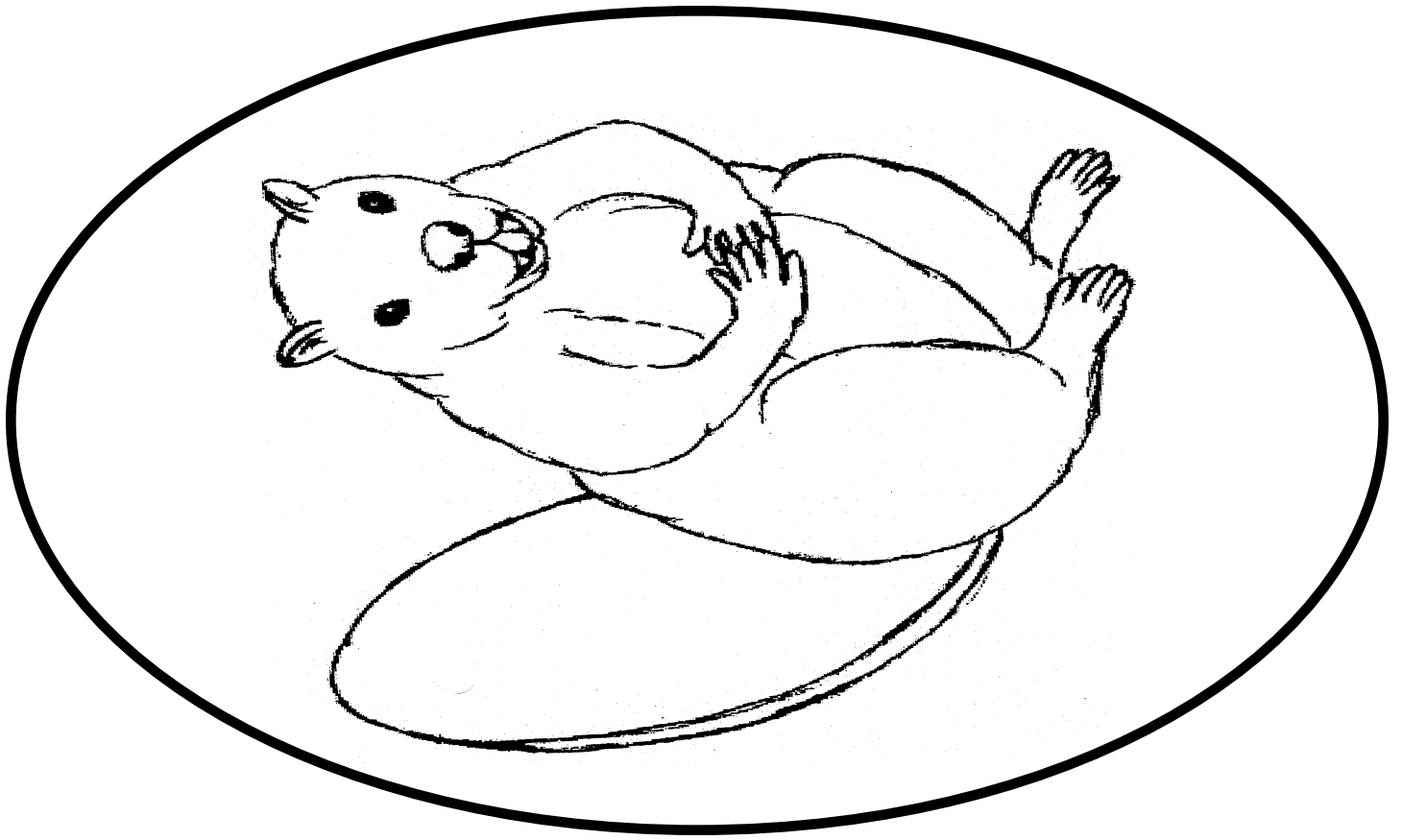
- Copies of the “We Don’t Tease” worksheet (one for each student)

- Scissors
- Staplers

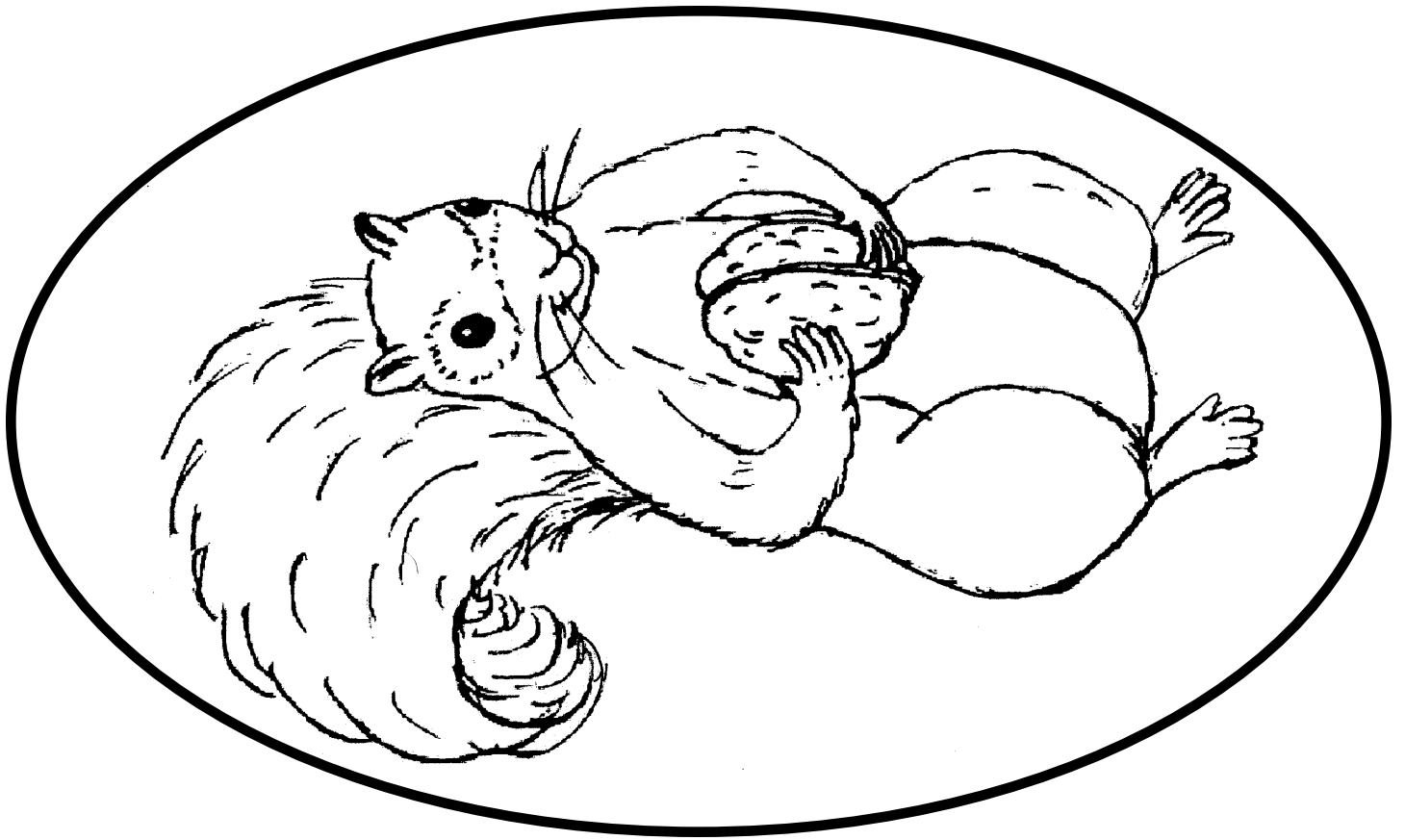
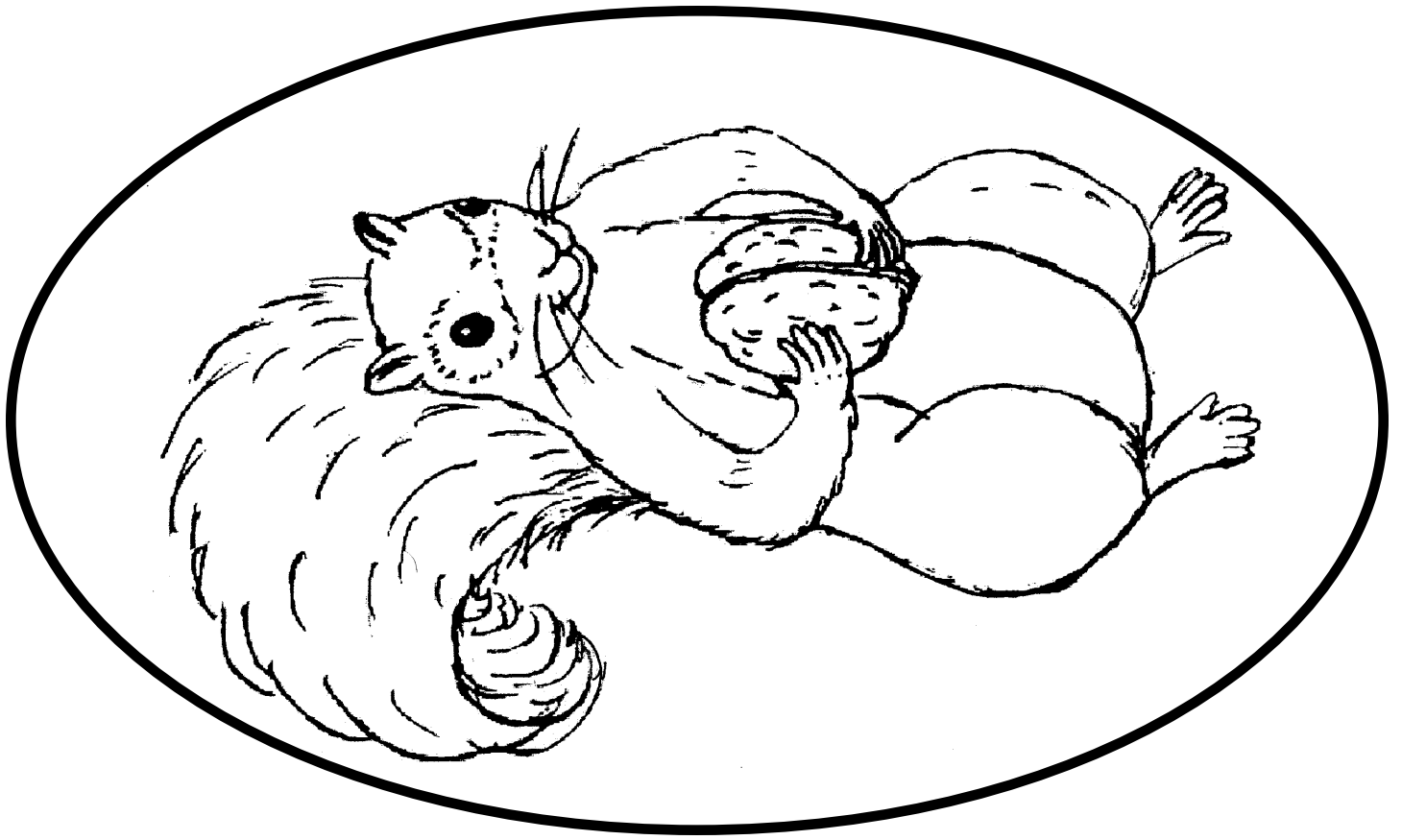
The second craft is a stick puppet. I have coloring pages of all the characters. Your students may pick two characters they like best, color them and cut them out. Then they can glue their characters back to back to a jumbo craft stick.

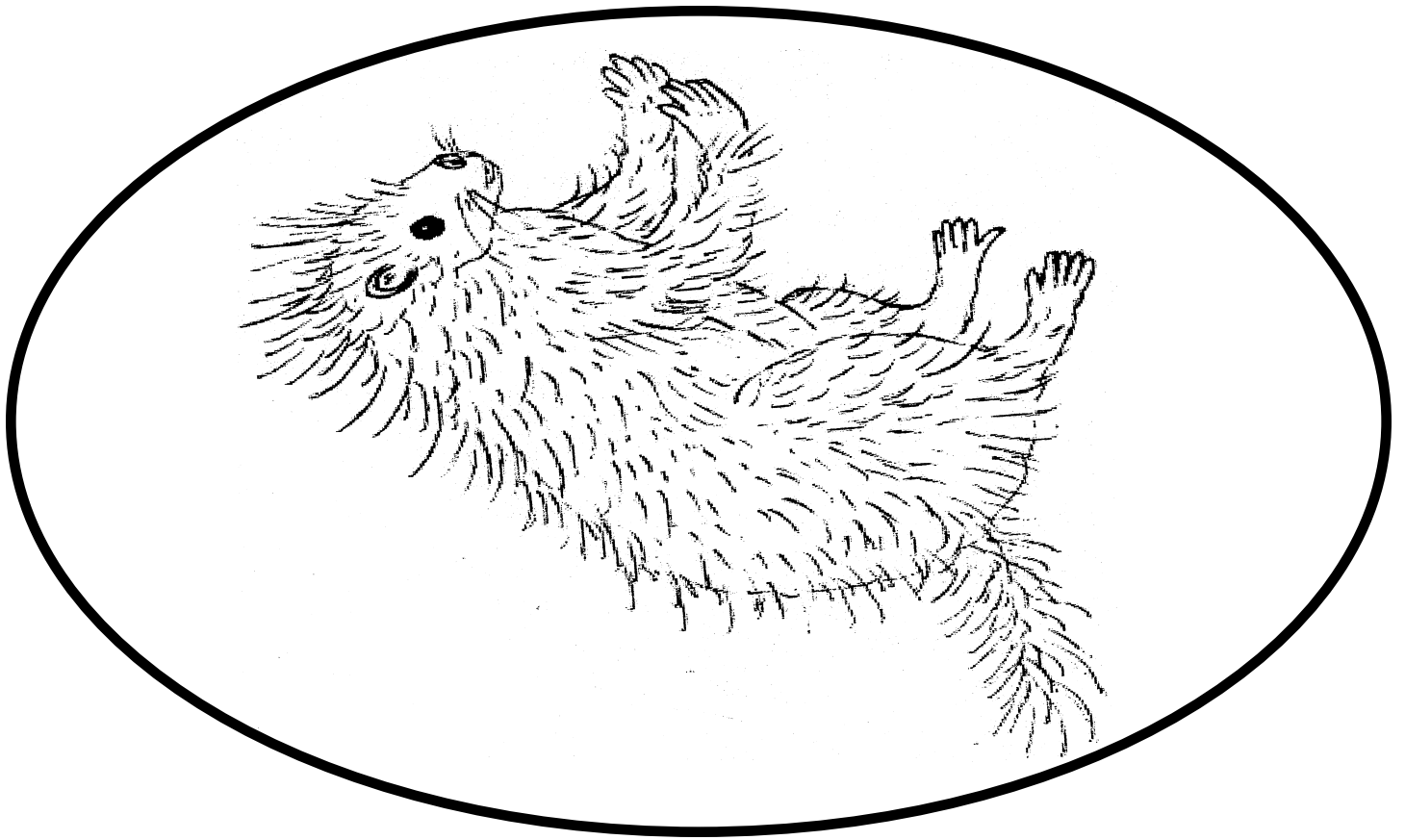
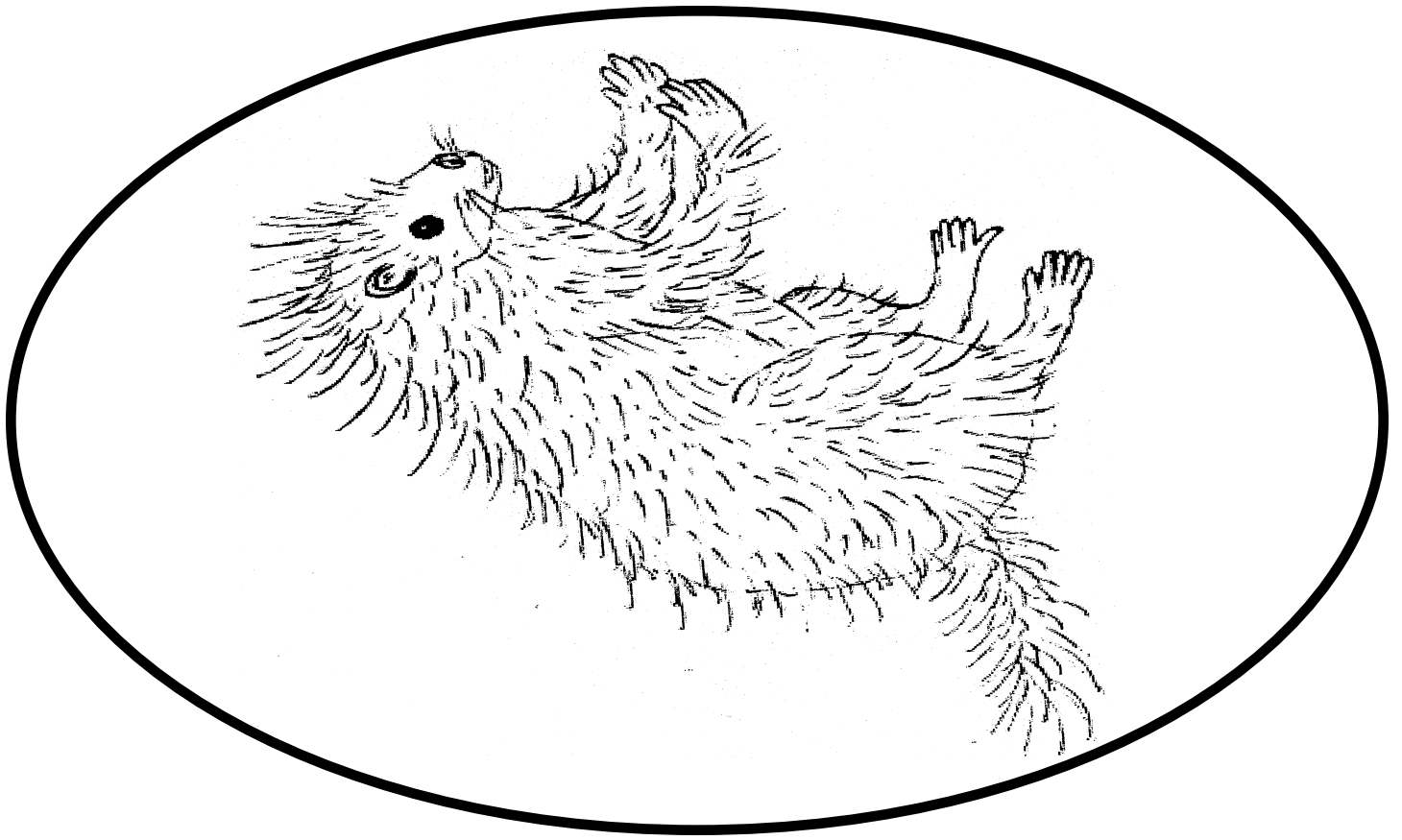
Supplies needed:
